The BMRA is the trade association representing the \pm 7 billion UK metal recycling sector – a globally competitive industry supplying environmentally friendly raw material to metals manufacturers.

BMRA's 300 members trade, process or supply services to enable the recycling of steel, aluminium, copper and most other ferrous and non-ferrous metals, and recycle a wide range of related products, such as end-of-life vehicles, packaging, batteries, domestic appliances, building materials and electronic goods.

BMRA members process over 12 million tonnes of scrap metal each year, which represents over 90% of the total metallic scrap processed in the UK annually. They also export over 80% of their output to companies throughout the world.

Membership is open to all UK metal recycling companies of good standing that have been in business for at least 2 years. There are also associate membership categories for international and service members.

The BMRA and its members operate under a strict code of conduct and clearly defined Articles of Association to ensure that the highest standards of commercial conduct and business ethics are maintained.

To maintain these high standards the BMRA has a formal application process that includes the requirement for new applicants to be nominated and seconded by directors of existing member companies. The application process also includes rigorous business checks and a bulletin system to solicit the views of the whole membership on the suitability of any new applicant.

The application process includes a declaration by the applicant that they agree to comply with the BMRA Code of Conduct and all relevant legislation and not do anything that will bring the BMRA or the metal recycling industry into disrepute

- 1. Complying with all UK laws, and fully endorsing the prohibition on any form of cash payments that contravene them.
- 2. Maintain the highest standards of commercial conduct and business ethics with other members, customers and suppliers.
- 3. Represent the metals recycling industry's common interests in their relations with business, government agencies and others.
- 4. Observe the highest practical standards of environmental care and protection and ensure compliance with current legislation.
- 5. Observe the need for good practice in health and safety and meet all relevant regulations.
- 6. Maintain adequate insurance cover for Public and Employee liability, and for other statutory requirements.
- 7. Co-operate with local authorities, regulators and other public servants, and allow access to premises where necessary.
