The Challenge


- Sector has a high rate of serious work-related accidents and fatalities
 - 31% of non-fatal Injuries (Slips, trips & falls)
 - 30% of fatalities (Struck by/contact with moving vehicle)
- No professionally recognised card scheme evidencing health and safety competence
- Time and resource intensive to undertake onsite health and safety inductions





Sector Collaboration


- CIWM and BMRA working in collaboration
- 21 April 2022 Metal Recycling Contractor Competency Scheme (MRCCS) launched
- 3 May 2022 First MRCCS Tests





The Solution – MRCCS with Digital Credentials

- Authenticated by a Pearson VUE test
- Evidenced via CIWM Profile (a digital credentials card)
- Designed to provide evidence of individual contractors' capability and competency
- Employers can quickly look up the health and safety competency of onsite contractors to:
 - Reduce accidents
 - Reduce time and resources
 - Reduce risk

MRCCS Test – How it works

- Two MRCCS Tests:
 - <u>Contractor Operative Test (26 MCQs)</u>
 - Contractor Supervisory Test (40 MCQs)
- 55 minutes for completion
- 85% pass mark
- Re-test every 3 years
- <u>Book via Pearson Vue to take the test at a Pearson</u>
 <u>Vue test centre</u>
- <u>Competence will be confirmed by a Pearson VUE</u> <u>test and evidenced via CIWM ProFile</u>

Operative – 12 topics Supervisory – 14 topics*

2. Manual Handling	9. Community Complaints
3. Working at Height	10. Health and Wellbeing



How it works

Gencarda

a digital credentials system, manages cardholders, CIWM ProFile card (and other cards if applicable) and credentials

CIWM ProFile

Gencarda issues the CIWM ProFile virtual card registration invites via SMS and email

Vircarda

A virtual wallet on your smartphone. Using Vircarda, the cardholder presents a short-life encrypted QR representing their card to Checarda for verification

Checarda

The Checarda app verifies Vircarda QR codes and displays the cards they represent






